2024 Specialty Show Information

PARKING: No Parking Charge for cars and vans!

- Cars, Vans, SUVs are to park at least 6 ft. away from each other.
- RV's are to park at least 15 ft. away from another vehicle and face same direction in their area.
- Overnight parkers refer to Reservation Form; arrivals must be by 9:00 PM for setup due to darkness.
- No common grooming areas will be provided. Grooming will be at your vehicle. Provide your own shade and cover.
- Electricity is not available on the site nor are there sewer hook-ups.
- Quiet time - generators are to be shut off between 11:30 PM and 6:30 AM.
- Exceptions are at the discretion of the day's Show Chair.
- This is a self clean-up weekend. You are required to take care of your business.
- Smoking is not permitted under the ring Pavilion or the covered all-breed grooming area.
- The health, safety and life of any dog on the grounds is paramount to other property and privacy rights. All vehicle owners on the grounds waive their right to legal actions or damages should it be necessary to rescue dogs from the confines of an overheated vehicle.
- Entry fees have been increased and daily parking fee eliminated to avoid unnecessary social contact upon arrival.
- Parking restrictions regarding vehicle distancing are in place to support social distancing.
- Overnight parking fees are to be prepaid to eliminate unnecessary social contact.

We are encouraging advance payment of overnight parking for the shows, making parking more efficient and everyone safer. We will accommodate RV'ers who arrive without having paid in advance; however an additional \$25 beyond the fees listed below will be required. DIRECTIONS:

From Ohio Turnpike: Leave I-80 at Exit 135 (Baumhart Rd). Go South on Baumhart Road to Route 511 (look for route signage to right at stop). Make right onto Rt. 511 and proceed to the event site

From I-71 South: Take I-71 North past Ashland and Exit at Rt. 301. Take Rt. 301 North to Rt. 224. Go West on Rt. 224 to Rt. 58. Go North on Rt. 58 to Oberlin. In Oberlin pick-up Rt. 511, turn left and go West to show site.

From I-480 East: Take I-480 West (past airport) to Rt. 10. Follow Rt. 10 and it will merge into Rt. 20 West. Exit from Rt. 20 West at Rt. 511. Follow Rt. 511 through Oberlin to show site (5 mi from city limits).

From I-90 East or West: Take I-90 to Baumhart Rd Exit. Proceed South and follow Baumhart Rd. to St. Rt. 511. At 4 way stop, turn right and proceed to event site which will be on the left. Watch for dog show sign and white rail fence.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (Single Dog Entries)

Veteran Dog/Bitch – For dogs and bitches that are seven (7) years old or older on the date of the show.

Hunting Dog/Bitch – For dogs and bitches that have achieved the ISCA VC-VCX Titles or the AKC Junior, Senior or Master Hunter Titles.

Field Trial Dog/Bitch – For dog and bitches that have placed in a REGULAR Stake at an AKC member or licensed Field Trial, other than puppy.

Spayed/Neutered dogs can compete in any single dog entry class at independent specialties!]

Winners of these classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed if not previously defeated in the Regular Classes.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (Multiple Dog Entries)

Stud Dog Class – For Stud Dogs and two (2) of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not be owner of the Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined

to determine if it has a condition that would require it's disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show rules. AKC policy or the standard for the Breed.

Brood Bitch Class – Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class,

Chapter11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that "a castrated male may be entered as Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and in Veteran Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class and Veteran Class.

Judge may award, at their discretion, up to three Award of Merits.

At the judges' discretion, Awards of Merit, to a maximum of three, may be awarded. The designation of an Award of Merit acknowledges this Irish Setter was under consideration for BOB or BOS, and indicates recognition of an exceptional animal who could, on another day, merit a top award.

Irish Setter Club of Ohio Sweepstakes is open to all Irish Setters, who on the day of the show will be six months and under eighteen months of age. All entries in the Sweepstakes classes **MUST** also be entered in a regular class. Entry fee for the Sweepstakes shall be \$10.00 plus the entry of the Regular Class. The Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes.

Irish Setter Club of Ohio Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Irish Setters, who on the day of the show will be seven years of age, and over. Veteran Sweepstakes entries need not be entered in a regular class. Entry fee for the Sweepstakes shall be \$10. The Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes. Ribbons/Rosettes for Veteran Sweepstakes shall be the same as for Puppy Sweepstakes. Entry Fee \$10.00

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

AKC Junior Handler Numbers are now required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club - PHONE (919) 854-0136.

Novice Junior Class-For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class-For boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class-For boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class-For boys and girls who are at least 10 years old and under 14 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class-For boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class-For boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

AKC National Owner-Handled Series

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. All dogs that are owner-handled and are not solely owned or exhibited by professional handlers meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book and the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in this competition.*

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

If the Best of Breed winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be the Owner-Handled Best of Breed.

If the Best of Breed winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed.

If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog and Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.

If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.

If the regular show Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog who competed in Best of Breed including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Best of Breed for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series.

*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertise or presented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

** A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.

- **ENTRIES CLOSE AT THE SUPERINTENDENT/SHOW SECRETARY'S OFFICE**, by 7:00pm on Wednesday, July 24, 2024 after which time entries cannot be accepted, altered, canceled, or substituted.
- **ENTRY FORM MUST BE SIGNED** at the bottom by the owner or the owner's duly authorized agent, otherwise the entry cannot be accepted. Telegraph or telephone entries cannot be accepted. **OVERNIGHT deliveries** requiring **NO** signature only. Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- **MAKE ALL CHECKS & money orders payable to Erie Canine Event Services (ECES)**
- **RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check.
- **OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE** for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT carefully, the information on entry forms to eliminate errors. There are PDF fillable forms on the Erie website!
- **A RECORDING FEE OF \$50** is to be collected **on the first entry only for each dog, each day**. An **Event Service fee of \$3.00** will be required for each regular class each dog is entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, Rally Trial or Tracking Test. These Fees are to be collected by the show giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). These are included in the entry fee. No extra payment is required.

- **NO ENTRY FEES** will be returned if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the management. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee.
- **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The Club or Show Secretary will not be responsible and is not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owner or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.
