SWEEPSTAKES

Offered by Triangle Shetland Sheepdog Club of NC

Entry fee \$8.00. Sweepstakes is open to all Shetland Sheepdogs who, on the day of the show, will be six (6) months of age and over and under eighteen (18) months of age. **Champions of Record are NOT eligible.**

Dogs shown in Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular entry form shown as "Additional Class".

CLASSIFICATION

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches

Puppy, 6 months & under 9 months

Puppy, 9 months & under 12 months

12 months & under 18 months

Beginner Puppy 4-6 Month Competition

One class (sexes combined) will be offered for Shetland Sheepdogs that are (4) four months & under (6) six months of age.

An AKC registration number or AKC litter number will be required for entries. A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

Dogs are required to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.

Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.* No dog may be exhibited with tape, glue or braces.

Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judges. Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy Competition.

- **ENTRIES CLOSE AT THE SUPERINTENDENT/SHOW SECRETARY'S OFFICE**, by 7:00pm on Wednesday, November 2, 2022 after which time entries cannot be accepted, altered, canceled, or substituted.
- **ENTRY FORM MUST BE SIGNED** at the bottom by the owner or the owner's duly authorized agent, otherwise the entry cannot be accepted. Telegraph or telephone entries cannot be accepted. **OVERNIGHT deliveries** requiring **NO** signature only. Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**.
- **MAKE ALL CHECKS & money orders payable to Erie Canine Event Services (ECES)**
- **RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check.
- **OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE** for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT carefully, the information on entry forms to eliminate errors. There are PDF fillable forms on the Erie website!
- **A RECORDING FEE OF \$.50** is to be collected **on the first entry only for each dog, each day. An Event Service fee of \$3.00** will be required for each regular class each dog is entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, Rally Trial or Tracking Test. These Fees are to be collected by the show giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). These are included in the entry fees.
- **NO ENTRY FEES** will be returned if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the management. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee.
- **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The Club or Show Secretary will not be responsible and is not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owner or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.
- **DOGS MAY ARRIVE ANY TIME PRIOR** to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
- **NO REFUND ON DUPLICATE ENTRIES.** Every effort will be made to find duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3 (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- 4 A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
