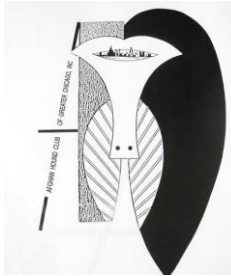

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION **AHC of Greater Chicago & Greater Detroit AHC**

CLASSES NOT DIVIDED

NOVICE CLASS: Shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first places awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

OPEN CLASS: Shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: Will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master to Open or Open to Novice if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placements, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department (919) 233-9767.

Each Owner and Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at a show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed & submitted the entry form.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused.

MOVE UPS

Effective for all shows held after July 1, 1990, dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the best of breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the superintendent or show secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of regular conformation judging at the show.

CLASSIFICATION

PUPPY DOGS, 6 MONTHS & UNDER 9 MONTHS; 9 MONTHS & UNDER 12 MONTHS, 12 MONTHS & UNDER 18 MONTHS, BRED BY EXHIBITOR, AMERICAN BRED; OPEN. SAME CLASSES IN BITCHES.

BRED-BY EXHIBITOR CLASS

As a reminder, the revised Bred-by Exhibitor Class Rule became effective September 18, 2002.

The Bred-by Exhibitor Class shall be for dogs that are:

- Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show;
- Individually registered with the American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show;
- Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show. The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog.
- In any subsequent classes for which a dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition. Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by the AKC. **GRAND CHAMPION POINTS** awarded for BOB, BOS, Select Dog, Select Bitch (effective May 12, 2010).

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES)

COMPETITIVE VETERANS

VETERAN DOG CLASS

VETERAN BITCH CLASS

For Dogs and Bitches 7 years & older,

Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in Veteran Classes. *The winners of these classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed Competition provided they have not been defeated in another class. After completion of Best of Breed the judge will select Best In Competitive Veterans.*

STUD DOG CLASS – For Stud Dogs and two to four of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or if a Champion of Record, for Best of Breed Competition or may be entered for Stud Dog Class only at the regular entry fee. The Get **MUST** be entered in one of the Regular Classes. The Stud Dog unit shall be considered as one entry and requires only one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. Get only to be judged on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show rules, AKC policy or the standard for the Breed.

BROOD BITCH CLASS – Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Telephone, telegraph and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. All entries must be submitted on Official AKC Entry Forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of front & back will be acceptable only if legible and official AKC size.

ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT SIGNATURE, FEES AND BACK OF ENTRY FORM WITH AGREEMENT.

ENTRIES CLOSE at the Show Secretary's office at **7 P.M., Wednesday, September 27, 2023**, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.

MAKE CHECKS payable to **ECES**". Third party checks will not be accepted. All Fees must be payable in US funds and drawn on US banks. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will charge a collection fee of \$25.00 for each returned check. The Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

MAIL ENTRIES with fees to Show Secretary, **ECES, 4300 Denison Ave., Cleveland, OH 44109** Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practicable. Should the exhibitor not receive such acknowledgment within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Secretary. **No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted** which specifies any conditions to its acceptance. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition be action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

No refunds on duplicate entries if processed. Every effort will be made to identify duplicate entries upon arrival. However, ultimate responsibility lies in the hands of the exhibitor.

Errors on entry forms. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fees will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

NOTE: "Effective for all shows held on or after July 1, 1980, dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for these shows, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety Competition provided this transfer is made to the Show Secretary at ONE HALF HOUR prior to the start of any regular competition judging at the show."
