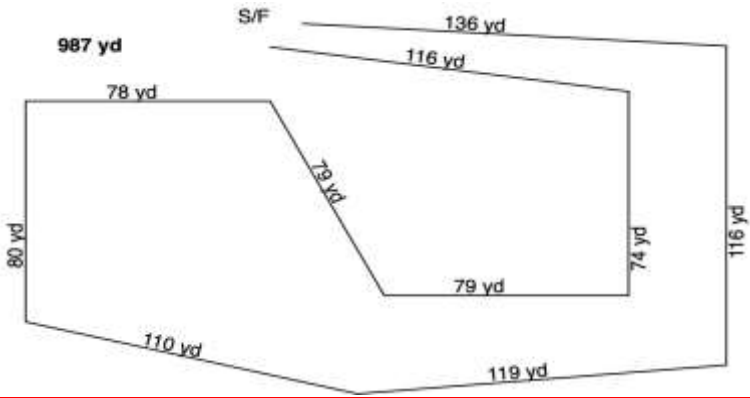

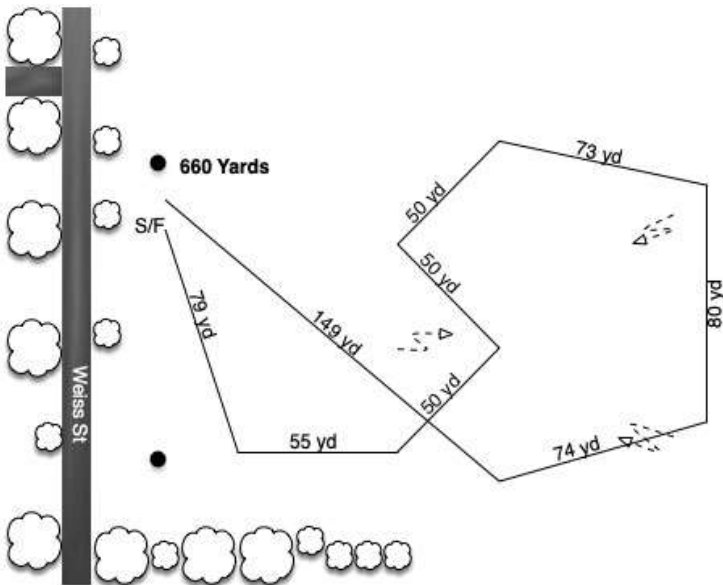
- A battery operated continuous loop lure machine will be used with highly visible plastic strip lure.

ELIGIBILITY & ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Only pure bred Scottish Deerhounds one year of age or older on the day of the test/trial. Single stake can have breed disqualifications.
- Dogs not present at the ending time of roll call will be scratched and no refund will be given.
- Entries will be acknowledged by email IF you include a legible email address on your entry form.
- Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications, and lame dogs will be excused. Entries will be refunded. NO BITCHES IN SEASON ON THE FIELD!
- A list of all award donors will be printed in the catalog.
- Spayed and neutered dogs are eligible to participate. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are ineligible.
- QC runs will be offered prior to this trial. You must provide your own hound to run with. LIMITED TO FIVE BEFORE THE TRIAL, others will be run after awards.
- There will be a minimum \$25 returned check charge.
- A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field that is not competing in the course in progress.
- A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any handler not cleaning up after their dog.
- Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds by the Trial Committee.
- **Children MUST be under control of their parents or guardians at all times.**
- Only the Lure Operator, Huntmaster, Judge, and Handler of the dog running in the course in progress will be permitted near the lure machine.
- Dogs must be individually registered with AKC (including PAL/ILP) or individually registered with a foreign registry whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. REGISTRATIONS CANNOT BE PENDING.

STAKES OFFERED AND RUNNING ORDER

- **Open:**
Hounds that have obtained AKC QC or ASFA certification, ASFA Field Championship title, or CKC Field Champions. Certificate or Title copy must be submitted with entry for first AKC Open stake entry. AKC Field Champions not eligible for Open stake.
- **Specials:**
Hounds that have earned their AKC Field Championship titles.
- **Veteran:**
Hounds eligible to enter Open or Special stakes and are 6 years of age or older.
